- Working closely with our members to ensure the communications strategy is based on member insight; leading our annual qualitative and quantitative insights & impact study delivered by Kantar to inform our strategy
- Defining the member journey, to define our strategic targeting approach
- Developing and monitoring impact KPIs for member engagement
- Building Chapter Zero's reputation and recognition through board networks and strategic partner networks
- Working with award winning creative agencies to develop our print advertising campaign in the FT International – running in 16 countries
- Manging external agencies and freelancers e.g. videographers, PR specialists
- Managing our brand licensing process for international Chapters
- Guardian of the brand across all channels
- Preparing a crisis preparedness plan with external crisis specialists
- Working with marketing departments across a host of strategic partners to amplify our co-branded content publications
- Leading development of our toolkits and playbooks
