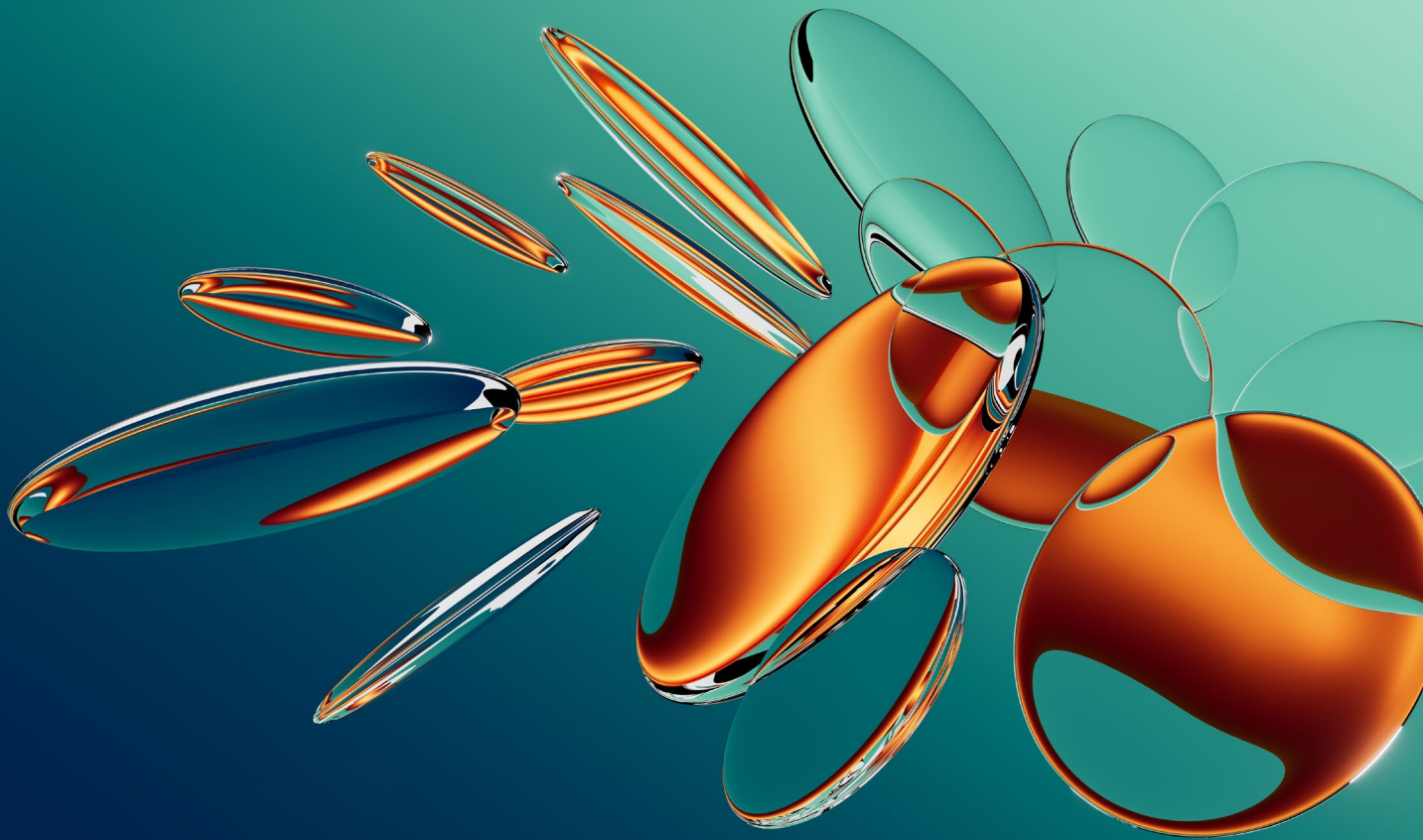

Why Chapter Zero matters to boards

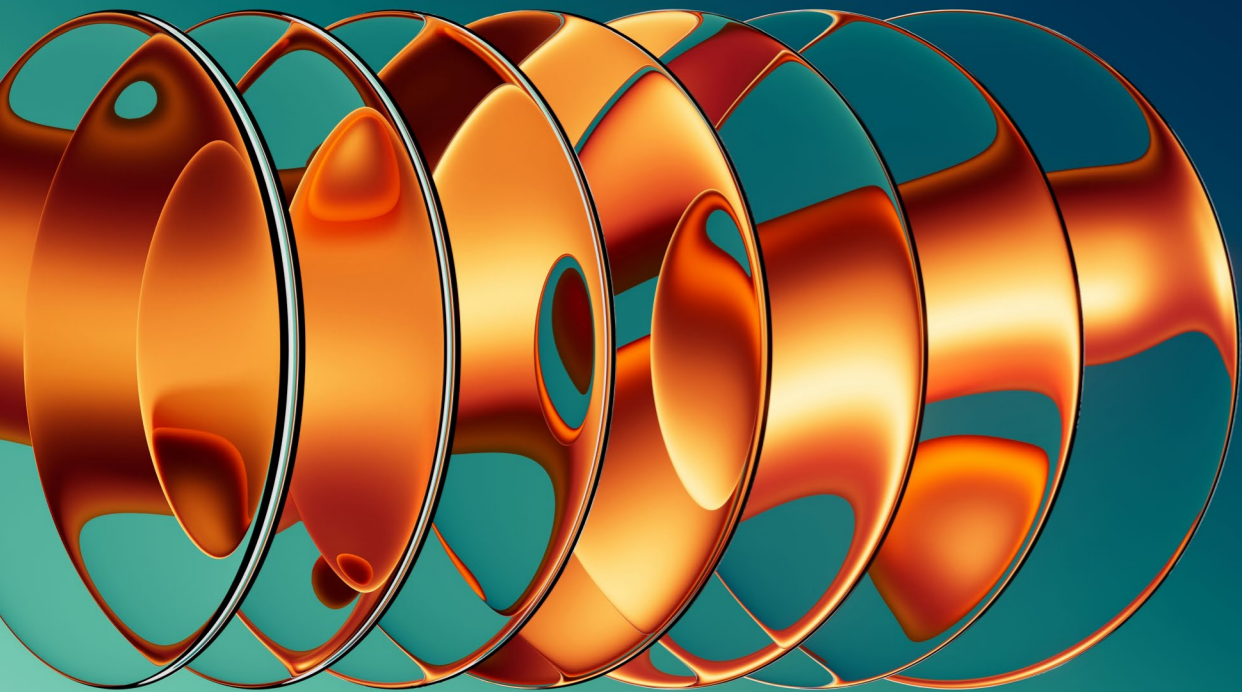

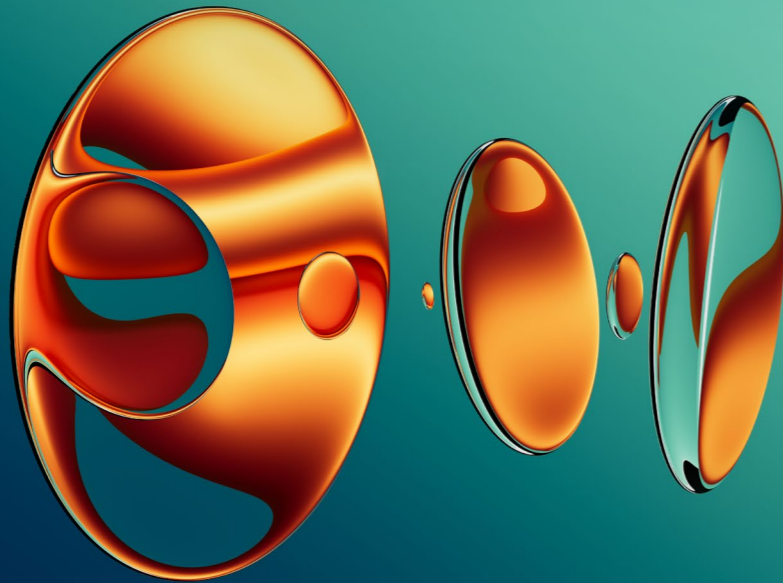

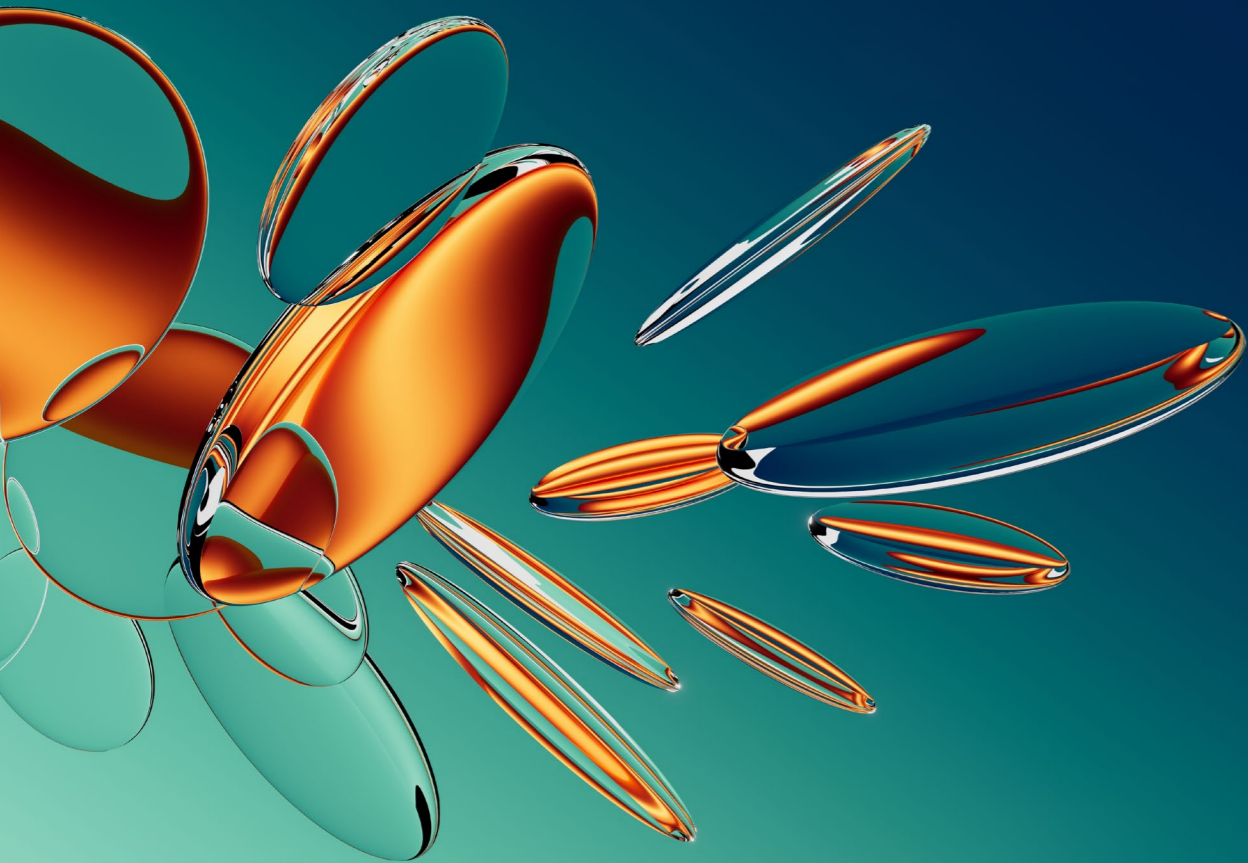

We are an inclusive group of Chairs, non-executive directors, trustees and beyond from business, government and civil society.

Our core offer focuses on the top 500 UK companies; we have over 80% representation from FTSE 100 businesses, and 70% of FTSE 250 businesses with one or more Chapter Zero member on the board. For some companies, the full board are Chapter Zero members; and in total over 1,000 committee Chairs are members.

We warmly welcome company secretaries as Chapter Zero members. We recognise their vital role as a bridge to the board.

Our Associate programme

Our membership not only comprises non-executive directors and Chairs, but also other senior leaders who benefit from our associates programme. How does Chapter Zero membership help senior leaders?

Through access to our virtual and in-person convenings, briefings, tools and other communications, we help you to embed climate action in your companies' business strategies. Four in five members have increased their climate awareness, four in five members have improved their climate knowledge and skills and three in four members are now more confident talking about climate after support from Chapter Zero.

How do we know membership supports senior leaders to have impact?

When climate shows up in capital expenditure decisions, and the pathways and milestones to investment are documented, we know board members and other senior leaders are taking action on climate. Our members tell us they take information directly

from Chapter Zero to their boardrooms, ask better questions in those boardrooms and have clearer climate-related oversight of all boardroom decisions.

Helping senior leaders imagine a decarbonised future

We ensure that senior leaders not only know about climate science, but they also know what to do about it in their boardrooms.

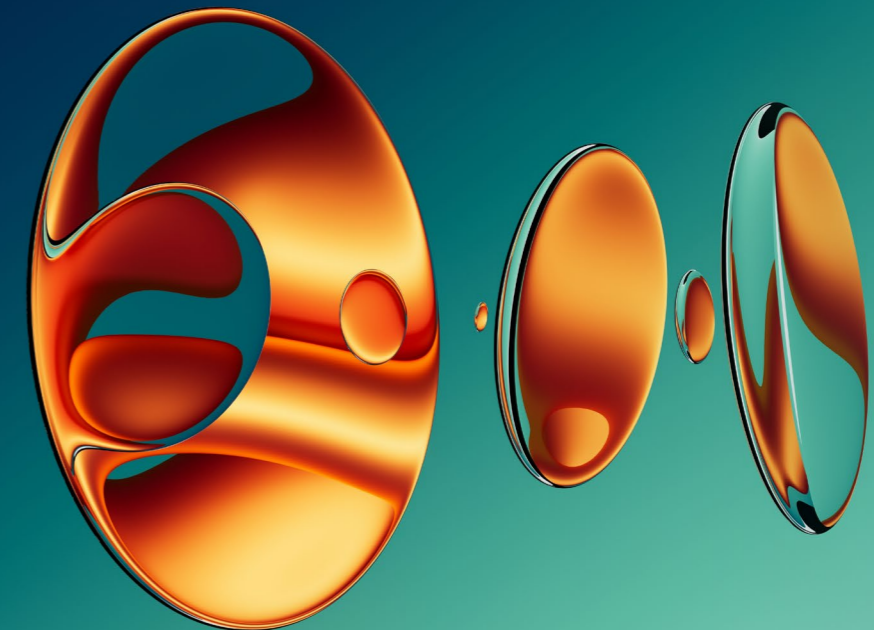

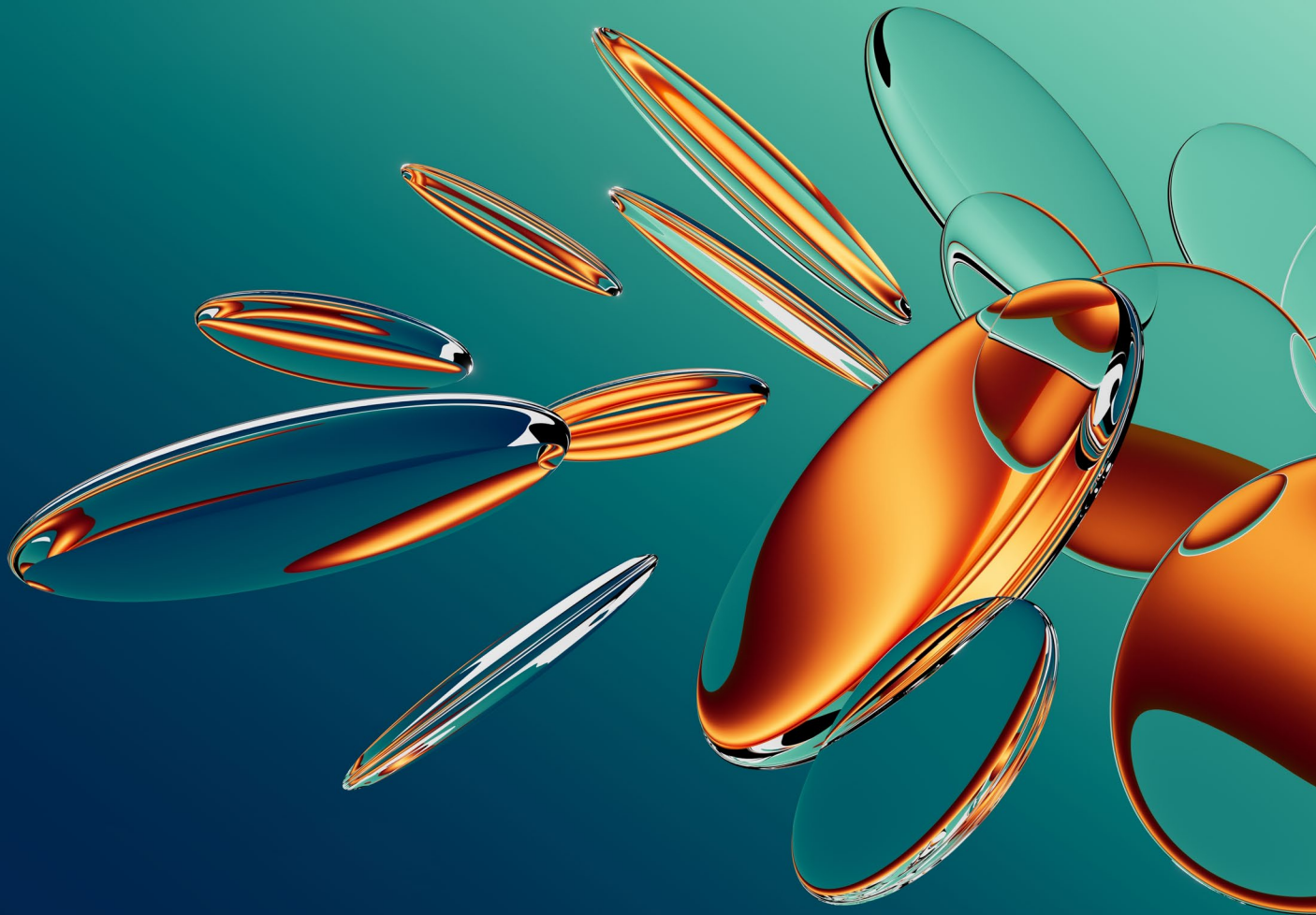
Values
